### MEDIATION FEE SCHEDULE

Mediation Fee Full Day \$1,200  
Per Party Half Day PI Case \$500  
Per Party Half Day Other Case \$675

The fee includes review of position papers and other relevant documents prior to the mediation session. It may also include speaking with the parties, if desired or necessary.

- If the session is conducted at the mediator's office, the fee includes deli lunch for all participants.
- There is no additional charge for travel to neighboring counties such as Collin, Denton, Tarrant, and Grayson.
- Persons or entities represented by the same counsel are considered one party for fee purposes.
  - Fees for multi-party, complex cases are negotiable.
  - Payment is due 3 days prior to the beginning of the mediation session.
- Arbitration fees and cancellation policy shall be determined on a case by case basis
